BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
MINUTES FOR SPECIAL CALLED MEETING**

**DATE: July 9, 2025**

**TIME: 9:00 a.m.**

**PLACE: City of Harrodsburg, Conference Room**

Mayor Robert “Bob” Williams called the special meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Members present, Commissioners; Kerry Anness, Charlie Mattingly and Marvin “Bubby” Isham.

**ROLL CALL**

Commissioner Anness – Present; Commissioner Mattingly – Present; Mayor Williams – Present; Commissioner Coleman – Absent; Commissioner Isham – Present.

**HIRE ANTHONY PINKSTON AS A POLICE SERGEANT**

Motion by/seconded, Mayor Williams/Commissioner Isham to hire Anthony Pinkston as a Police Sergeant at \$27.00 per hour pending drug and alcohol test. Mr. Pinkston is a certified officer. Motion carried unanimously.

**HIRE BRIAN BEELER AS A POLICE OFFICER**

Motion by/seconded, Mayor Williams/Commissioner Anness to hire Brian Beeler as a Police Officer at \$25.00 per hour pending drug and alcohol test. Mr. Beeler is a certified officer. Motion carried unanimously.

**ACCEPT ROB ONEY’S RESIGNATION**

Motion by/seconded, Mayor Williams/Commissioner Isham to accept Rob Oney’s resignation from the Police Department effective July 6, 2025. Motion carried unanimously.

**APPROVE PAY RAISE FOR MICHAEL SHEPERSON**

Motion by/seconded, Mayor Williams/Commissioner Mattingly to approve a pay raise for Michael Sheperson for graduating the Police Academy on June 26, 2025. His new rate of pay will be \$19.00 per hour. Motion carried unanimously.

**APPROVE PAY RAISE FOR DOMINIC PUSEY**

Motion by/seconded, Mayor Williams/Commissioner Anness to approve a pay raise for Dominic Pusey for graduating the Police Academy on June 26, 2025. His new rate of pay will be \$19.00 per hour. Motion carried unanimously.

**HIRE TRINTON SOUTHERS AS WATER TREATMENT PLANT OPERATOR TRAINEE**

Motion by/seconded, Mayor Williams/Commissioner Isham to hire Trinton Southers as a Water Treatment Plant Operator Trainee at \$16.64 pending background check, drug test and alcohol test. Motion carried unanimously.

**AUTHORIZE MAYOR WILLIAMS TO SIGN THE REPUBLIC SERVICE CONTRACT**

Motion by/seconded, Mayor Williams/Commissioner Isham to authorize Mayor Williams to sign the Republic Service contract pending City Attorney approval. Commissioner Mattingly said he and some of his neighbors have called Republic Service and they are giving mixed answers. He said they told him that if he takes the senior citizen discount, he has to give up one can. He currently has two cans. Commissioner Mattingly said he thought if you had two cans it would be \$54.00 every three months. City Attorney Norrie Currens said she will have to go back and look at the bid tab. She said on their bid they attached their pricing. She said what she is hearing is that their customer service is inconsistent with what they are telling people. Ms. Currens said the contract has gone back and forth and she thinks they are agreed. Commissioner Anness said so we still haven't approved this yet. Ms. Currens said we haven't signed a contract yet. We accepted their bid but we have not signed a contract yet. She said we can hold off on signing the contract until we get some of the wrinkles ironed out if that is what you prefer. Commissioner Anness said he is getting multiple stories about what they are being told. Mayor Williams said so is he. Ms. Currens said she would suggest perhaps that we have a negative vote on this motion and bring it back on. Commissioner Mattingly said he thought that if you were a senior, you got the 20% discount it would be \$54.00 every three months. Ms. Currens said that was her interpretation, but she will try to get in touch with this gentleman. She said they don't communicate with her any better than they communicate with anybody else. Mayor Williams asked if there were provisions in this contract for cancellation if we are not satisfied with the service. Ms. Currens said there are. Mayor Williams said we need to make sure we keep an eye on those. Everyone voted no. Motion did not pass.
